

Human Trafficking advocacy delegation to Cambodia

- Day 1 Arrival in Siem Reap- Welcome and and diner with cultural performance
- Day 2 Visit cultural site to Angkor Wat and other ruins
PM: briefing on Cambodia recent development and history (include situation on human trafficking) by Boreth a Local NGO leader or Government official
Diner together at Butterflies Garden Restaurant
- Day 3 AM: Visit vulnerable community and floating village
PM: Visit Angkor Hope Hospital for children- a hospital for vulnerable Cambodia families
Visit Krousar Thmey: an NGO work with rescued and vulnerable kids
- Day 4: AM: Visit Sangkheum Center for Children (an NGO working to provide support for vulnerable children)
PM: Rest and wrap up or visit to rural villages to observe community life
- Day 5 Travel to Cambodia-Thai border to visit an NGO working with vulnerable children along the border
Stat in Battambang Province
Diner at a local restaurant
- Day 6 AM: Visit Phar Ponle Selpak, a local NGO working to support vulnerable communities-
PM: Visit Rescued women center, discuss with the group and leaders
Diner at local restaurant
- Day 7 Travel to Kampong Chang Province to visit Christ Center for Women- meet with the women, discuss issues with them and lunch together with the women
Over Night stay in Phnom Penh
- Day 8 AM: ASFISIP, a local NGO working to prevent human trafficking and provide support to rescued women
Visit HAGAR- a Christian NGO working to provide support to trafficked women
Dinner at Haga restaurant or at Nyemo

- Day 9 AM: Visit Nyemo, an organization working to provide skill training support and job placement to Cambodian women
PM: VCAO
Dinner at Nyemo restaurant
- Day 10 Whole Day: Visit to vulnerable communities outside of Phnom Penh and meet with community leaders to discuss about their living situation and struggle for better life. Students can visit individual family home to discuss about their struggle for better living conditions
- Day 11 AM: Meet with US Embassy officials for briefing on Cambodia trafficking situation (not yet confirm but working to arrange this) and visit ChildSafe Center
PM: Wrap up
Dinner at local restaurant
- Day 12 AM: Meeting with Student groups working on social issues and community training
PM: Meeting with Friends, an NGO working to provide skills to street kids.
Dinner at Friends Restaurant
- Day 13 AM: Visit Genocide Museum and the Killing Fields and briefing with Mr. Kassie Nou, a Cambodia leader working with the Khmer Rouge Tribunal
